Scenario:

How to read a certificate .crt/.csr file in case of need

Solution/Steps Taken:

In case of crt

\$ openssl x509 -text -noout -in /etc/nginx/ssl/server.fullchain.crt

In case of .csr

\$ openssl req -text -noout -verify -in myrequestform.csr

Note that it is possible to extract some part only with commands like:

openssl x509 -in /etc/nginx/ssl/server.fullchain.crt -noout **-dates** notBefore=Sep 28 11:44:56 2023 GMT notAfter=Oct 22 11:44:56 2024 GMT

openssl x509 -in /etc/nginx/ssl/server.fullchain.crt -noout **-subject** subject=C = GB, ST = Scot, L = Edi, O = Viavi, OU = V, CN = olin-3
